Submission Guidelines

rubric works on an open submission basis, with all works reviewed by an editorial panel and selected on merit alone, as such we ask for no CVs to be included with submissions. We are interested in receiving works which utilise the potential of a journal format to engage with the particular thematic.

All forms of work will be considered whether visual, text based, or other media.

To submit to rubric please send us:

- Written submissions (as a rough guide 2000 words maximum, we will consider more if it is critical to content.) Please submit either a Word document (.doc or .docx), a PDF file, or in .rtf format. Citations should be included as footnotes, a guide to *rubric's* preferred formatting can be found on the website at www.rubricjournal.org/files/rubric-citations.pdf
- Image submissions (300 dpi, preferably JPEG or PDF format.) The work should be formatted so as to fit A5 (210mm x 148.5mm) for a single page or A4 (297mm x 210mm) for a double page spread. Include relevant written material if desired.
- Other media. We are interested in expanding the possibilities of digital content, and exploring the crossover between digital and print editions. As such we are inviting submissions for work which bridges the gap between these modes of dissemination. Submissions should include an outline of the work plus any relevant supporting material.
